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Medicare- Client Information

CIMT is a non-participating provider for Medicare. We do not accept assignment. This means that you pay for services at the time of treatment. We will give you a receipt for your records only. We submit your claims to Medicare. Medicare reimburses you directly. If you have secondary insurance, in most cases, the claims go directly from Medicare to your secondary insurance, depending on how you have set this up between Medicare and your secondary carrier. You will then receive a check from your secondary insurance carrier.

As of February, 2017, we are submitting claims electronically, instead of submitting paper claims by mail. This change is making the claims submission process quicker and more efficient. However, at times, reimbursement may be delayed. If this occurs, you will need to contact Medicare. You will need your dates of service and your Medicare number to find out the status of your claims. Please keep CIMT informed about what you are being told by Medicare. You may either email or call Lisa, our appointment person, with the information. She will forward the Medicare information to Diane, our Medicare claims person. She will resubmit the claims when needed.

Please bring the following to your first appointment: Medicare card and physical therapy prescription signed by your doctor. The prescription must be dated on or no more than 30 days prior to your first physical therapy appointment. Once you start treatment, we are required by Medicare to do a re-evaluation every 30 days. Lisa will ask you to come 15 minutes early to fill out functional forms, and will remind you to get a new prescription from your doctor, per Medicare requirements. Your physical therapist will send a Plan of Care to your doctor for each re-evaluation. If it has been more that 30 days since your last physical therapy treatment, you will need to get a new prescription from your doctor before resuming physical therapy.

Fees: Initial Evaluation (clients who have never been seen at CIMT) 90 minutes, \$250.
Initial Evaluation (clients returning to CIMT with a new problem) 60 minutes, \$170.
Re-evaluation, \$170.
Treatment session- 60 minutes, \$160
- 45 minutes, \$120
- 30 minutes, \$80
